Classroom Happenings

The senior class will be a lot smaller over the last two weeks while Freya and Milla complete their study tour (holiday) in Bali. We are sure that they are getting plenty of practise speaking Indonesian and that they are enjoying the warm weather in Bali.

Periodically the senior students complete online tests to assess their progress in Literacy and Numeracy. The tests provide students with a standard score showing at what level the child is working at, and also assists the teacher to identify individual strengths and weaknesses.

Over the last couple of weeks, the students have completed tests in Spelling, Reading and Number & Algebra. Each of the students is very proud of their results, and can see big improvements since the start of the year.

This week the students received letters from students in East Java in Indonesia. Erin and Blake have already replied (in English and Bahasa Indonesia).

In Art/Science the students have been busy constructing Indonesian huts out of straws and pop sticks. In Writing our focus has been on Quick Write -15-20 minutes creative writing based on a picture stimulus. These have been great fun and even Mr.M writes during these sessions.

The senior students will soon be commencing to write their speeches for the Lions Club Public Speaking. Our focus will then quickly shift towards publishing books for the Book Awards.
