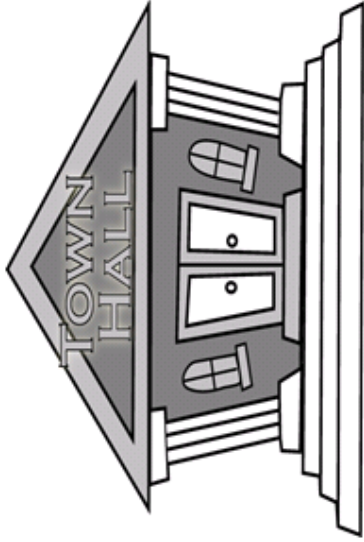
Congratulations to Jacob and Keigan who traded in 10 tokens and have ordered their first reward for 2017.
